2 Funeral Alternatives and Burial Reform in Northern Ireland

DD introduced Scott Charrington who provided a presentation on his request for a review of sustainable funeral and burial alternatives in Northern Ireland.

Scott recently wrote to MLAs calling for a legislative review of burial practices to reduce the associated climate and environmental impacts associated with funerals and burials. A briefing note was circulated with the meeting papers.
